Dr. Bart Van Goethem graduated from Ghent University (Belgium) in 1996 where he then did an internship. He briefly combined working at his own private practice with a part-time function as surgical assistant at the teaching hospital. Between 2001-2004 he enrolled in a surgical residency at Utrecht University (the Netherlands). Next he worked in several veterinary referral clinics in Belgium. In 2005 he started working at the surgery department of the Small Animal Teaching Hospital at Ghent University. He became a Diplomate of the European College of Veterinary Surgeons in 2007 and in 2009 he became head of the small animal soft tissue surgery clinics. His research on 'Innovations in Canine Gonadectomy' led to a PhD title from Utrecht University in 2016. He is author and co-author of 6 surgical book chapters, has published over 60 peer-reviewed articles in his field of interest, gave over 2000 national and international lectures, and reviews articles for 7 scientific journals. He is an enthusiastic propagator of video-endoscopic surgery and is currently exploring the clinical benefits of fluorescence guided-surgery.
